Notes on Viewing the Charts


Kepler most often drew his charts in sets of six on one page. We give a sample of a page here, with numbers showing the order in which the charts are described in the figures. Sometime there are only two charts per page, and these are described from top to bottom. Each figure includes its Pulkovo volume number, folio number, and *recto* or *verso*. All but Figure 1 have corresponding pages of transcriptions in *GW* 21, 2.2, and these are also listed with each figure.





Figure 2. Kepler's Paternal Grandparents, Sebald and Katharina Kepler (*Pulkovo 21, 404r* = *GW* 21, 2.2, pp. 6-7)







Figure 4. (top) Michael Mästlin, Solar Return 1595 (bottom) Martin Crusius, Solar Return 1594 (*Pulkovo 21, 475v* = GW




Figure 8. Charts of Tycho Brahe (natal), Balthasar Wagan (Solar Return 1595), Balthasar Wagan (natal), Balthasar Wagan (Solar Return 1584), Balthasar Wagan (Solar Return 1585), Balthasar Wagan (Solar Return 1594) (*Pulkovo 18, 217v* = *GW* 21, 2.2, pp. 288-289)





Figure 9. Natal Charts of Andreas Vesalius, Caspar Creuziger, Helius Eobanus Hessus, Caspar Peucer, Johannes Schoener and Georg Sigismund Seld (*Pulkovo 18, 218r = GW 21, 2.2, pp. 290-91*)






Figure 10. Natal Charts of Johann Ludwig Fabricius, Michael Mästlin, A Procurator (in secret writing), Vitus Lieb, Albert Kuon, Johannes Well (*Pulkovo 18, 223r* = *GW* 21, 2.2, pp. 302-4)





Figure 13. Natal Charts of Anonymous, Dr Johann Pfrentzscher, Albrecht von Wallenstein (secret writing), Gerhard von Taxis, von Wartemberg, blank chart (*Pulkovo 18, 250v* = *GW* 21, 2.2 pp. 381-82)
